I have recently learned that you were the one who helpfully brought to the attentions of Pastor Branson two most unfortunate and erroneous expressions in his book, Drama of the Ages, implying that Christ actually took our sinful, fallen nature.

I know the outcome of this in the correction of the pages, agreed to by Pastor Branson, and I would be glad to know what led you to detect this error. Was there some agitation at the time? Was it something that the Brimsmeads were teaching at that time--along about 1955, I believe it was.

We have come a long way in trying to correct these statements. One of the corrections was made in <u>Bible Readings</u>. And many men who formerly were confused on this have a clear position, but we have not, denominationally, had very much agitation over this matter. The book, <u>Questions on Doctrine</u>, was, I believe, instrumental in helping to get the correct position before our men.
