We are told that the Father is all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. The same is repeated of the Son. He is all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. And again in the same passage, that the Holy Spirit is all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. Our forefathers did not have too clear a view of this. they thought maybe the Holy Spirit was the totality of the angels who could be everywhere present. They looked upon the Holy Spirit merely as an impersonal influence of power. The Holy Spirit is a person--a divine Person, the third Person of the Godhead--to Whom we yield ourselves for His empowering and His infilling, and the tremendous work of preparing a people fully to meet our God.
