Dear Brother Porter:

I was very happy to have a little time with you on Sunday afternoon. I thought that possibly you might be interested in one emisode that I failed to tell you of.

As I mentioned, the book, Questions on Doctrine, has had a profound unifying effect as pertains to the three areas that it covered in the three Appendix items in the back.

Elder C. S. Longacre was an Arian, ready to take on anyone who held a different view. When this book came out Miss Louise Kleuser of the Ministerial Association had an apartment in his home. She tells me that he studied those compilations, and studied them, and came to the conclusion that they were right and he was wrong, and he simply stopped his discussion and agitation and defense of Arianism thereafter.

I could tell you of many a case where this had had a rather profound effect upon the lives and the thinking of men. I believe that I will send you a set of the three parts of the study on the Deity of Christ that you may see for yourself one of these presentations, prepared primarily for those not of our faith and therefore not drafting upon the Spirit of Prophecy.

As to your enquiry about whether there would be a possibility of my coming to Northern Europe, I told you the facts and the convictions of men relative to the priority of bringing out the book. Further, I never go any place unless the leaders are profoundly convinced that this is a timely message that ought to be given in their territory, and will give me every backing. Then we will have success. Otherwise I would never wish to go to any field.

I am not hinting or suggesting that that wouldn't be the

case in Northern Europe, but there is not basis, of course, for their having any interest or confidence in it. They could, obtain from any one of a dozen men who have heard the series and have seen the effect of the presentation that which I believe would satisfy any question.
