observe that your comments on Arianism make no allusion to any statements in E.J. Waggoner's writings. not sure that you see the full import of the material that I sent you. Dr. E.J., unfortunately, made three expressions in the early part of his Christ and His Righteousness which have been seized upon by those who wish to depreciate his work and position. These cannot be ignored, and it is difficult to deal with this material without recognizing their existence, because if this is not frankly done, others will seize upon this as being a biased or one-sided presentation. How I wish that somewhere there was, in the words of E.J. Waggoner, an express statement of disavowal of all Arian connotations and an express belief in the eternal pre-existence of Christ! But I don't suppose we shall find this."
