The point of this note is that for a number of years, many years, I have been gathering materials, in harmony with a request of A. G. Daniells, that I make a thorough study of the true history of the development of the doctrines of salvation in this movement. We were divided in our views concerning the nature of Christ, whether eternally pre-existent and eternally and completely divine or whether He was a subordinate being, either holding the Arian view or the semi-Arian view, the relationship of the Atonement to the cross, and the matter of the Trinity and the personality of the Holy Spirit.
