I could give several reasons for this decision, but I hardly think it necessary, and I feel certain that the brethren at the General Conference office will concur in my decision.

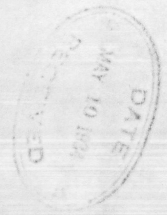
